

ADMISSION POLICY

As the university comes under Brownfield Category, having been established by converting an existing autonomous college into a university, the rule of reservation in admissions for the seats of the erstwhile college continues to apply to the University also, to the extent of the seats approved for the college till it became a university. As per the existing rule, 70% of the seats approved for the college till 2019-20 will be filled as per the State Government rules/ EAMCET. The balance 30% and university programs can be filled up by the university itself.

In case of the academic programs that were offered by AGI and which continues as part of the Brown-field University, 70% of the students are admitted through the special entrance conducted by the Telangana state government: Engineering Agricultural and Medical Common Entrance Test (TSEAMCET). The balance 30% of the students are admitted through JEE/ EAMCET/ Academic Record.

In case of the academic programs offered by the University, the admissions are done through a special National level entrance exam called AnuragCET.

As per. the Section 33 of the Telangana State Private Universities Act No. 11 of 2018, and Rule 10 of the G.O.Ms. No. 26 [Higher Education (UE.1) Department], Dt. 20-08-20.19;

- (i) 25% of seats for admissions in all the faculties /courses undertaken by the University shall be exclusively reserved for the students, who studied for at least two years in the State of Telangana;
- (ii) Children whose parent/parents born or worked at least for two years in the State of Telangana shall be treated as students of Telangana for this purpose.

Provided that the vacant seats shall be 'open to General Category.

Note: In addition to domicile-based reservation, community-based reservations also apply. As Anurag University has been established under the Brown-field Category, the State Govt. rules for community reservations that were applicable to erstwhile AGI are still being followed.

For the seats filled as per the State Government rules/ EAMCET, the fee is recommended by the Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (TAFRC) and approved the Board of Management. For the other students, it is fixed by the Fee Fixation Committee of the University based on the cost of providing various programmes.

The University shall have full autonomy, along with full disclosure and transparency, on starting various academic programmes and admit students as per the Statutes and Act.

Admissions to the university programs will be based on a rank in the Anurag University Common Entrance Test (AnuragCET), or JEE/Central or State Level Entrance Test (TSEAMCET) or Marks scored in 10+2 or any other test prescribed by the Governing Body as per Section 33 of the Telangana State Private Universities Act No.11 of 2018, and Rule 10 of the G.O.Ms. No.26 [HIGHER EDUCATION (UE.1) DEPARTMENT], DT.20-08-2019.
