

AnuragCET Merit Scholarships

Eligibility:

- The eligibility criteria for students to write AnuragCET 2024 are same as that of EAPCET.

Mode of Examination:

- The syllabus for AnuragCET is same as EAPCET.
- AnuragCET shall be conducted for 90 minutes duration with 80 multiple-choice questions (40 Mathematics, 20 Physics & 20 Chemistry).
- Each question shall carry 1 mark and negative marking is not applicable.
- Student needs to score 25% of marks (i.e. 20 Marks) to qualify for AnuragCET Merit Scholarship Test.
- The AnuragCET Merit Scholarship exam shall be conducted for all qualified students in Offline mode at Anurag University Campus, Venkatapur, Hyderabad.

Rules & Regulations to avail the Merit Scholarship:

- The scholarships awarded are applicable to students taking AnuragCET for admissions into B.Tech courses for the academic year i.e., 2024 – 2025
- To continue availing the scholarships for the next consecutive academic year, the rank holder should
- Pass all the subjects in their regular examinations (without backlogs) and maintain at least 8 CGPA in their current year.
- Maintain 75% attendance in each semester.
- Not participate in ragging and other activities which would attract disciplinary action.
